What will I learn?

Through this course, you will:

- revise important grammar structures, and functions
- develop your exam taking techniques and strategies
- develop your reading sub-skills
- develop your listening sub-skills

What are the components of the course?

The course content includes reading, grammar, and listening components.

- The reading component consists of reading adapted and authentic texts (from magazines, newspapers and interoffice correspondence such as memos, business letters, forms and tables, bulletins and advertisements).
- The listening component consists of listening to statements, questions and responses, short conversations and talks.
- The grammar phenomena covered in this course include: tense/aspect, subject-verb-agreement, pronoun reference and agreement, conditionals, noun and adjective clauses, comparisons, causative, subjunctive, modals, word order, articles, adverbs, etc.
- The vocabulary in this course will include: two-word verbs and business vocabulary.

Will I practice taking the test?

The course will include three in-class tests: one at the beginning of the course used as a diagnostic test, one in the middle of the course used as a progress test, and one at the end of the course used as an exit test. Throughout the course, students will also have take-home tests.
