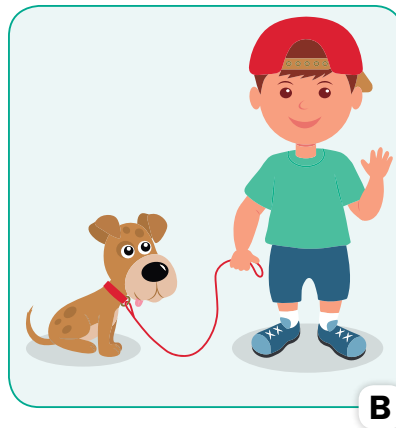
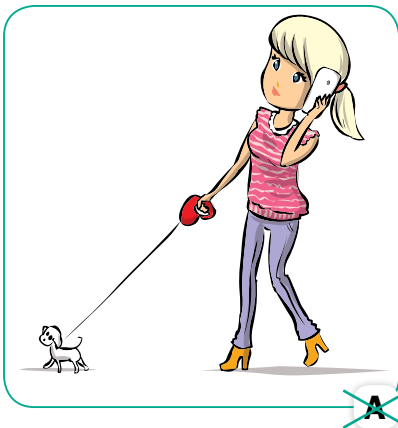


LISTENING SECTION
